Shull Early Learning Center provides certified programming with a highly qualified staff. Shull ELC is open from 6am to 6pm. Our full day option provides class and care up to ten hours a day. We offer both 4 and 5 day a week classes; full time, part time or a class only option. Outside of class time we offer care in our Sharks Den.

5 days a week Pre-Kindergarten classes offer two sessions of certified class time, choose: 8:00-11:15 morning class session or 12:00- 3:15 afternoon class session. Each class will have up to 20 students, 1 certified teacher and 1 paraprofessional.

4 days a week Early Childhood blended classes are held Monday-Thursday with two sessions of certified class time, choose: 8:00-11:15 Morning class or 12:00-3:15 Afternoon class. Each class will have peer models with special needs students for a total of 12 students. Each class has 1 certified teacher and 1 paraprofessional.
