



# Fall 2020 - Phase 1 PROTOCOLS



## HEALTH AND HYGIENE

- Training for staff and students
- Additional hand sanitation stations
- Hand washing will be required
- Staff and students strive for 6-foot separation
- Daily temperature check of staff and students



## FACILITIES AND ROUTINES

- No large group assemblies
- No fountain use (students bring water bottles)



## ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

- Parents stay in vehicle
- Follow established school protocols
- Students report to classroom upon arrival



## BUS TRANSPORTATION

- Additional cleaning and sanitation procedures
- Drivers and monitors will wear masks while students are loading and unloading
- Students should utilize face coverings at all times



## CAFETERIA PROCEDURES

- Students wash hands prior to eating
- Food items will be individually packaged
- No student self-serve items offered
- Disposable trays and utensils will be used
- Touchless check-out system for students
- Meals will be consumed in the classroom



## MASKS/FACE COVERINGS

- For grades 6-12: Face masks will be utilized when closer than 6 feet
- For grades PreK-5: Face masks will be utilized when closer than 3 feet
- For students with special needs, exceptions may be granted on a case-by-case basis



## NO VISITORS

- No parents or visitors in the school building



## RECESS

- Students wash hands before and after recess
- Additional supervision to assist in encouraging social distance guidelines



## SPECIALTY COURSES

- At elementary schools, specials (except physical education) will take place in the classroom
- Equipment sanitized regularly



## STAY HOME WITH THESE SYMPTOMS:

- Fever of 100 degrees or higher
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Cough
- Chills
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Muscle pain



## ISOLATION PROTOCOL IF SYMPTOMS PRESENT AT SCHOOL:

- Mask required
- Student isolated
- Parent picks up (no bus transportation)
