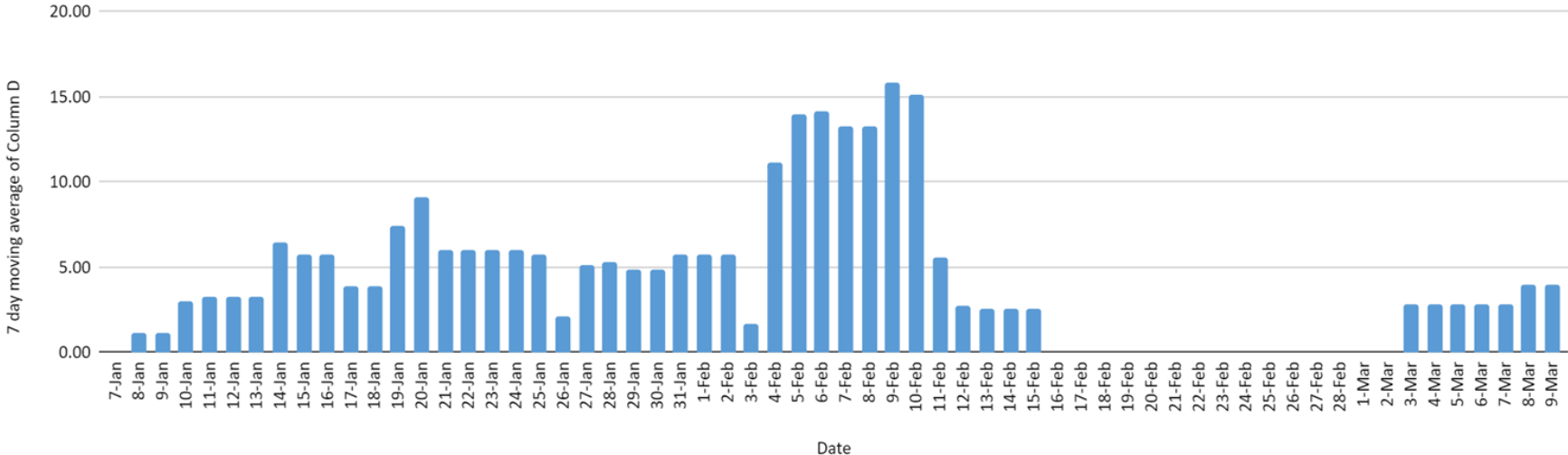

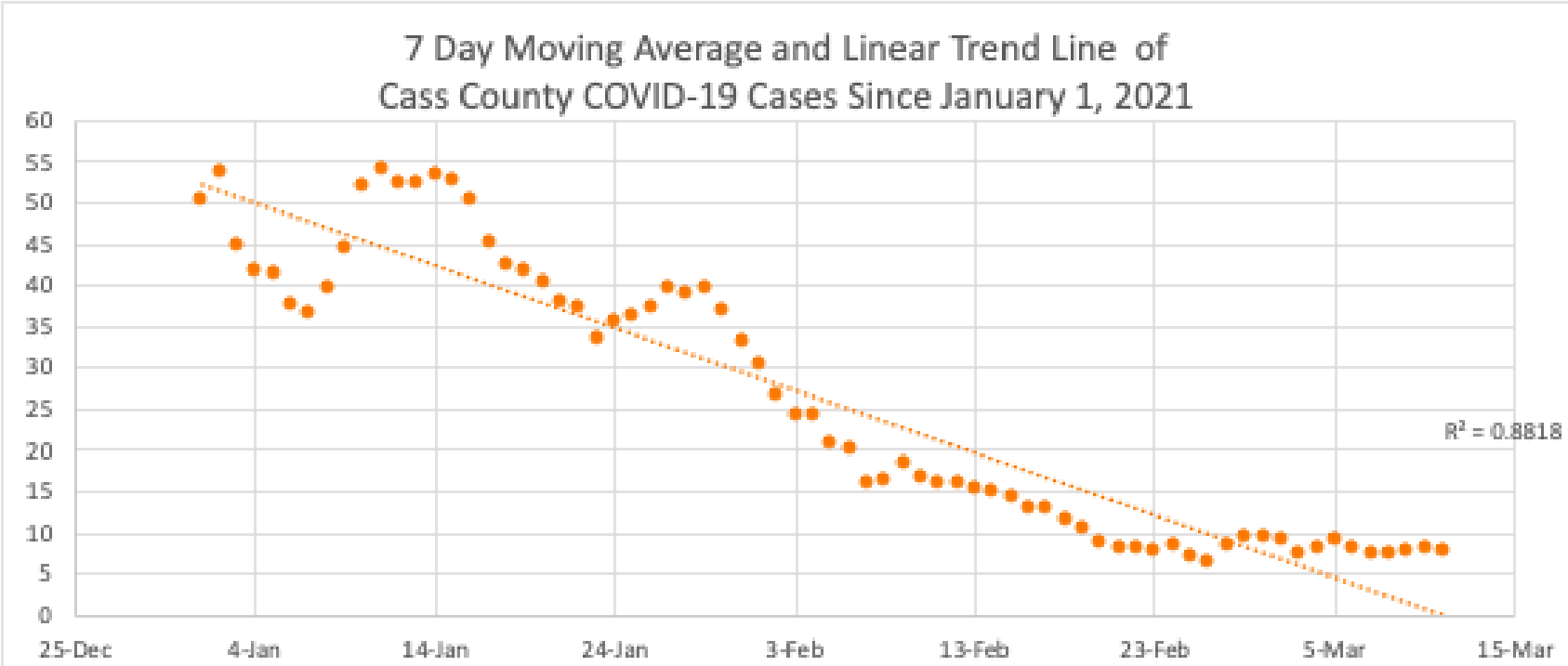

# Survey Results

---

## Among parents

- Total number of responses: 1,112
- Percent wanting to stay hybrid for the rest of the semester: 39%
- Percent wanting to have more in-person days after teachers are vaccinated: 18%
- Percent wanting to have more in-person days ASAP prior to vaccinations: 43%

## Among secondary school staff members

- Total number of responses: 344
- Percent wanting to stay hybrid for the rest of the semester: 65%
- Percent wanting to have more in-person days after teachers are vaccinated: 16%
- Percent wanting to have more in-person days ASAP prior to vaccinations: 19%

## Among secondary school students

- Total number of responses: 2,340
- Percent wanting to stay hybrid for the rest of the semester: 44%
- Percent wanting to have more in-person days after teachers are vaccinated: 23%
- Percent wanting to have more in-person days ASAP prior to vaccinations: 33%

# Other School Districts

---

Among the larger, top-tier Kansas City metropolitan area school districts in the Suburban Conference, here are the in-person learning plans at the secondary level (information as of March 11):

- North Kansas City
  - Currently hybrid. Planning to transition to a 5-day in-person schedule on March 22.
- Lee's Summit
  - Plans varied throughout the school year. Transitioned to a 4-day in-person schedule on February 8.
- Park Hill
  - Currently hybrid. Planning to transition to a 5-day in-person schedule on March 22.
- Liberty
  - Currently hybrid. Planning to transition to a 4-day in-person schedule on April 5.
- Blue Springs
  - Started the school year in 5-day in-person learning.
